Forfeit Fixtures – Guidance notes for the application of penalties

- Basic penalty for any forfeit game is 5-0 loss with additional penalties subject to Grade
 - Grades 2 / 3 / 4
 - Standard penalty: 5-0 loss and 1point deduction
 - progressive additional points deducted for repeat offences
 - fines if appropriate
 - Additional Penalty: points deduction for lower team at same grade.
 - Where the forfeiting team's next lowest team is also within these grades (and their game is played) then the points deduction applied above (1 point, 2 points etc) will also be applied to that lower team.
 - E.g., for a first offence, if the lower team plays then the result will stand but there will be a 1point deduction, whatever the score.
 - Note: this may seem harsh on the lower side, but this additional deduction is applied because the club should be forfeiting the lower team match in order to play the higher team match at these more competitive Grades.

Grades 5

- Standard penalty: 5-0 loss and 1point deduction
 - 1 point deduction for repeat offences (progressive as appropriate)
 - No penalty applied to any lower teams which play (subject to standard Fair Selection & Player Eligibility)
 - Not applicable to Development Teams.

ALL GRADES

ALMC monitor forfeit games and have discretion to apply further penalties
(additional point deductions, fines, goal difference) if they consider the forfeit has a
significant impact on another teams or teams e.g. where the previous result was
greater than 5-0, or players clearly dropped to strengthen a lower side etc.
