










Test analysis in TestVision – version 1.2, October 2021

After administering the test, test results and analysis are available in TestVision.

Steps to view analysis, modify results, validate psychometric data and download results.	
1.	Log in in TestVision. Go to Published tests and click on Analysis behind the right test.
2.	In the lefthand corner of the screen, click again on Analysis . Analysis data of the test appear. 
3.	Click on Frequency distribution to view the distribution. 
4.	Click on Item analysis . 
5.	View item results and read comments of students made during the test. By clicking on i → Question details and question can be viewed. 
6.	In righthand corner click on Close .
<i>Do you wish to modify questions?</i>	
7.	Click on Modify in the lefthand corner of the screen. 

8.	Click on Item result .	
9.	<p>Three types of modifications:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Consider the question correct for all students - Exclude the question for all students - Modify answer option: add an option as correct or select another option as correct. This is possible for Multiple Choice and Multiple Response questions. <p>It is <u>not</u> possible to adjust the maximum score of a question.</p>	 <p><i>Based on item analysis and students' comments decide what to do with each question.</i></p>
10.	Click on Check modifications to view the effect on attempts passed or failed.	 <p>NB. If it is not desirable that one or more students fail because of the modification, choose Consider correct instead of Exclude.</p>
11.	To save psychometric data in to the Question database, click on Validate in the bottom righthand corner.	<p>The button Validate saves average p-corr, p-value, a-values and a range of the rit-values. This button is only active for the original item analysis. After applying modifications: click in the righthand upper corner on View original.</p> <p>NB: Validation can not be undone.</p>
12.	Click on Close .	

13.	Go back to Home and click on Sessions .	
14.	Click on Results of the right test.
