I. Administrative Matters

1.1 Declaration of interests – Board Members declared that they had no conflict of interest in relation to the matters to be discussed in the meeting.

2. Technical Updates

- 2.1 The Board agreed that the work plan should be published on UKEB website.
- 2.2 The Board noted the forward agenda.

3. Board members sponsoring projects

- 3.1 The Board recommended replacing sponsor with liaison with reference to the Board Member's involvement on the projects.
- 3.2 The Board agreed an approach to board member involvement in individual projects. This would depend on Board member interest and diary constraints.
- 4. Introduction with Operations Director

- 8.1 The Board considered progress on development of a Service Level Agreement with the FRC.
- 8.2 The Board delegated the Chair to sign the service level agreement on their behalf once the SLA sub-committee has finalised the draft.

9. Any other business

- 9.1 The Board recommended that once the Secretary of State has delegated the statutory functions to the Board, the introductory paragraph of the comment letters to IASB and others should be revised to reflect this fact.
- 9.2 The Board noted the need for an active engagement strategy for the project on adoption of IFRS 17 *Insurance Contracts*.
