ABOUT DKMS

Every 20 minutes someone in the UK is diagnosed with a blood cancer such as leukaemia, lymphoma and myeloma. For many of those affected, a blood stem cell donation from a matching donor represents their best, and sometimes only, chance of beating this devastating disease.

Despite being treatable and potentially curable, blood cancer today remains the fourth leading cause of cancer deaths in the UK, and still claims the lives of more children in the UK than any other disease.

Finding a tissue match is extremely rare. With more than 8,500 known tissue characteristics that can occur in millions of combinations, finding a match is a bit like winning the national lottery!

At DKMS we believe that no blood cancer patient should die because they are unable to find a matching blood stem cell donor. We urgently need to raise funds in order to continue our work registering as many potential donors as possible, so that a suitable match can be found for every patient who needs one.

We're using this World Blood Cancer Day to celebrate these lifesaving matches. And what better match than delicious wine and cheese to raise funds so more people with blood cancer find their own perfect match?

ALFIE & CHRISTIN - A PERFECT MATCH

Alfie Commons, 4, from Nottingham was just 7 months old when he was diagnosed with aggressive leukaemia.

Alfie's mum, Lorna, says "I was heartbroken, our world completely feel apart. Leukaemia hadn't even crossed my mind - I WAS SHELL SHOCKED THAT MY INNOCENT BABY HAD CANCER.

Devastatingly, the first round of chemo failed and at this point, we were told that Alfie's only chance of survival would be a bone marrow transplant. Worse was to follow, his second course also failed and on the same day, we were told that Alfie's brother, Billy wasn't a blood stem cell match for him either. The fear of losing Alfie was overwhelming, I felt helpless but I had to carry on for Alfie's sake."

"During the third round of chemo, we had been told that a donor had been identified which was the only good news we'd received since this nightmare began. ALFIE WAS ABLE TO HAVE THE TRANSPLANT. "

In the weeks and months following the transplant, doctors closely monitored Alfie's progress, and were encouraged to see his body accepting the donor's stem cells, which were now producing cells of their own.

Christin, 34 and a school teacher, had been on the blood stem cell registry for a number of years before she received a letter to say that she could be a match in 2016. Following a number of tests, it was confirmed that she was a match for Alfie.

Christin says; "When they told me that the

recipient was a baby - I just cried. After I donated my bone marrow and the anesthetic wore off, I called DKMS as I needed to know more. They told me that Alfie was a small baby and living in the UK. I still can't describe that moment but so many tears of joy ran down my face. It's a moment that is always with me and whenever I feel a bit down, I think back to it as it always brings me so much happiness!"

"TO BE A DONOR AND TO HAVE HAD THE CHANCE TO SAVE A LIFE HAS BEEN ONE OF THE BEST MOMENTS OF MY LIFE. I will always be wedded to Alfie; he is such a special, brave boy. I am so proud that I had the chance to be a part of his life. Donating the bone marrow was such an easy and uncomplicated process and nothing compared to what Alfie and his family went through. I was able to help them during this terrible time and to help Alfie fight cancer. So far,

this is the best thing that I have done in my

entire life."

Lorna added; "There is a match out there for everyone with blood cancer, people just need to come forward and register. I want people to know that by being a potential donor, you can have an enormous impact not only on the patient's life but their whole family. I'VE GOT TO SEE MY CHILD GROW FROM A BABY TO A TODDLER AND THEN TO A LITTLE BOY AND ONWARDS, it's the greatest gift that anyone could have ever given.

"I'm just so proud of Alfie; the odds were always stacked against him and at every step nothing went his way, things only got worse yet he fought so hard to stay exactly where he belongs."

It costs DKMS £40 to add every potential life-saver, like Christin, to the blood stem cell registry. With more of these amazing people on the register many more people with blood cancer, like Alfie, will be able to find their perfect match and have a second chance at life.
