Westport

It is no surprise that Westport, one of Fáilte Ireland's Heritage Towns, has developed into one of the premier tourist destinations in Ireland, rich in culture and energy.

As one of the few planned towns in the county (James Wyatt 1870), its classic Georgian town centre is particularly noteworthy. The planning of the town was commissioned by the Marquess of Sligo of the stately home, Westport House, one of the area's premier tourist locations

Visitors to the town can soak up the continental atmosphere while strolling along the tree-lined Carrowbeg river (known locally as the Mall). Colourful flower displays are many and plentiful while the town is packed full of shops with character and bustling cafes, restaurants and pubs.

In Westport, you can enjoy a variety of activities, historical walking tours, cruises, relaxing spa treatments or be entertained at the Town Hall Theatre.



Croagh Patrick Mountain

Croagh Patrick has been a pilgrimage destination since pre-Christian times, with thousands of people descending on the area on the last Sunday in July to climb and throughout the year.

Saint Patrick like many an intrepid traveller chose the location for its outstanding natural beauty. Hill walkers archaeologists, nature lovers and the famous are drawn here. Other highlights are Murrisk Abbey and the National Famine nt, an outstanding John Behan sculpture, depicting a skeleton strung 'coffin ship'. Counties Sligo and Mayo

Tracing a jagged and dramatic line along Ireland's western shoreline in the heart of the Wild Atlantic Way, the captivating landscapes of counties Sligo and Mayo have long charmed artists and adventurers in search of unspoilt beauty and some of Europe's most sought-after surf breaks.

Mayo is the more rugged of the two, a land of stone-walled fields, heathercovered moors and dramatic cliffs. Offshore settlements like **Clare Island** vide a glimpse of an elemental, traditional lifestyle largely dictated by he forces of nature, while the county's splendid natural bounty is spread out in the huge, scenic Ballycroy National Park, made up of one of the largest areas of blanket bog in Europe.

he county's hardscrabble history is explained in compelling detail in nuseums like the **Jackie Clarke Collection** in Ballina, made up of 100,000 objects covering 400 years of Irish history. Just outside Castlebar, in the handsome grounds of 19th-century Turlough Manor, the National Museum of Country Life tells the story of rural Ireland from 1850 to 1950, while the country's prehistoric past comes alive in the stone houses and megalithic tombs of the Céide Fields, perhaps the world's most extensive Stone Age

Standing sentinel over them all is Ireland's most sacred mountain, Croagh **Patrick**, whose 772m-ascent is both an act of faith and a chance for stunning views over magnificent Clew Bay and its eve-catching collection of sandy islets. Nearby, photogenic Westport is an elegant Georgian town with handsome, tree-lined streets and a fine collection of restaurants and

Smaller and less remote, County Sligo's bucolic charms and ancient history have nonetheless beguiled poets and painters for generations, not least the Yeats brothers, William and Jack, who devoted much of their considerable genius to representing Sligo's majesty and mystery on page and canvas.

They were drawn to the ancient secrets of Carrowkeel and Carrowmore, megalithic sites that were already old when the pyramids of Egypt were built. Sligo's most distinctive peak, **Benbulben**, so enchanted Yeats the poet that he insisted on being buried in its shadow, with the words from his poem Under Ben Bulben as his epitaph.

Sligo's collection of hiking trails and waterways make it a paradise for walkers and anglers, while its sculpted coastline is dotted with beaches like Easky, Inishcrone and Strandhill that are a popular gateway to some of Europe's very best **surfing**. So, grab your boots, camera and board – Sligo

cemetery, Knocknarea Mountain is crowned by a large flat-topped cairn called 'Miosgán Meadhbha' (Maeve's Lump). Folklore suggests that it was built for the mythical Maeve, the Iron Age Queen of Connacht Walkers can access from both sides via a track from base to summit.

The Glen – a narrow, deep and long chasm on the south face of Knocknarea - is one of the most interesting natural phenomena o the Coolera peninsula. It is popularly supposed that this unique passage was formed by some eruption or earthquake which parted the side of the mountain and tore apart the vast strata of limestone.

Split Rock, Easky

Local legend holds that the rock was split as a result of an argument between two giants on the Ox Mountains, one of whom was Fionn Mac Cumhaill. It is believed that if anyone walks through the split three times it will close.

Dead Man's Point, Rosses

According to folklore, Dead Man's Point is named for a foreign seaman who died as his ship was entering the port; he was hurriedly buried here by the crew who were anxious not to miss the tide. As they were not sure if he was really dead, they buried him with a loaf of bread!

Diarmuid and Gráinne's

Cave, Gleniff Horseshoe According to folklore, the cave is Diarmuid, who died of his wounds

while hunting with the jealous Fionn, and of the broken-hearted Gráinne who died by her own hand; her last view was of Gleniff through the mouth of the cave. It is well worth a careful visit. Bring a good pair of boots and your imagination.

The Magic Hill, Gleniff Horseshoe

The Magic Hill is under the shadow of Tievebaun Mountain. Park your car, let the handbrake off and your car will magically freewheel uphill. Drive with caution.

Located at the head of a valley between the cliffs of Benmore and Croaghaun Mountain, to reach this idyllic spot just follow the Atlantic Drive to Keel and continue westward via a cliff-top road with spectacular views of the Atlantic Ocean.
