Discover More



Waterford Explore the oldest city in Ireland and walk around the Viking Triangle to feel a thousand years of history in a thousand paces. Visit one of the many museums and see the rich history from Viking age right up to modern day. Pop into the world's first virtual reality experience at The King of The Vikings on Bailey's New Street or find the cannon ball up high in Reginald's Tower. Discover the Choristers' Hall in the Medieval Museum and marvel in the great treasures on display at Bishops Palace. The city has many shopping centres, boutiques and craft greas to discover, with The House of Waterford Crystal being a must visit while you are here. With a wide range of cafes, restaurants and bars offering mouth-watering award-winning culinary delights, why not try the speciality bread of the city, the Blaá who's recipe dates to the 17th Century.

Dunmore East 15km from Waterford city, explore the secluded coves, scenic headlands and beautiful beaches of this magical coastline. Get out on the water and try kayaking, sailing or paddle boarding. Give angling a go at Dunmore Harbour, wander through the enchanting Dunmore East Woods and in the evening, enjoy a delicious meal in one of the local restaurants.

Tramore 15km from Waterford city, is a popular seaside resort. Stroll along its stunning promenade that overlooks a 5km stretch of golden sandy beach and sand dunes. The 2km cliff walk with its breathtaking views over the ocean brings you out of town to the Coastguard Cultural Centre and Café where you can enjoy uninterrupted panoramic views of Tramore Bay.

The Copper Coast Drive embraces panoramic seascapes, cliffs, bays and coves between Tramore and Dungarvan. At the heart you will come to the Village of Burnham with its long sandy beach and the Copper Coast UNESCO Geopark where you can visit the Heritage Centre and see the history come to life. Take a stroll through time in the Geopark Garden that is situated

beside the beach or pick up one of the many trail cards that will take you along the coastal cliff paths with their beautiful sea views, flora, and fauna. Further south, Dungarvan is a beautiful coastal harbour town. Stroll through the quaint streets to discover the Norman Castle and County Museum stopping at one of the many award-winning restaurants along the way.

Waterford Greenway A 46km off-road cycling and walking trail which travels through time and nature across eleven bridges, three impressive viaducts and a long atmospheric tunnel all the way from the River Suir to Dungarvan Bay. Along the route you will pass by the Mount Congreve Gardens, visit the seventy-acre garden woodlands containing a four acre Walled Garden and home to one of the largest collection of plants in Ireland. Further along the route in the Village of Kilmeehan, you will arrive at the Waterford Suir Valley Railway where you can take a journey on the narrow-gauge railway line along the river Suir through Fairy Gardens and Castle ruins. Halfway through the Greenway, you will arrive at the village of Kilmacthomas and cross one of the three viaducts with the stunning backdrop of the Comeragh Mountains. A further 15km and you will reach the Ballyvoile Tunnel looking as perfect as the day it was built in 1878 where you will walk along two more viaducts. A 10km scenic walk from here brings you to the Harbour town of Dungarvan.

Lismore 66km West of Waterford city is set on the banks of the River Blackwater at the foot of the Knockmeeldown mountains. Visit Lismore Heritage Centre and explore its many gems, experience the history of Lismore Castle in virtual reality. Escape one of the challenging rooms at Robert Boyle Escape Rooms or rent a canoe and paddle down the pretty river. Further south is Ardmore a scenic coastal resort with a wonderful sandy beach. Back in amazing views on the Ardmore Cliff Walk, stop by the ancient Ardmore Round Tower and Cathedral by St. Declan's Oratory.
