IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Vehicle accident	Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Call the emergency services: Dial 111
Spill or leak	In case of spillage it is important to take all steps necessary to avoid eye and skin contact and avoid contamination of waterways. Keep all bystanders away. Wear full length clothing and PVC gloves. Reposition any leaking containers so as to minimise further leakage. Dam and absorb spill with an absorbent material (e.g. sand or soil). Shovel the absorbed spill into drums. Disposal of the absorbed material will depend upon the extent of the spill: for quantities up to 50L of product bury in a secure landfill site and for quantities greater than 50L seek advice from the manufacturer before attempting disposal. Contain in a secure location until disposal method is established. Decontaminate the spill area with detergent and water and rinse with the smallest volume of water practicable.
Fire	Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. When fighting a major fire wear full protective clothing. Fire will produce black smoke containing hazardous products of combustion. Exposure to decomposition products may be a hazard to health. Do not allow fire water to enter drains.

FIRST AID

If swallowed	For advice contact the National Poisons Centre on 0800 POISON (0800 764 766), or a doctor immediately. If swallowed seek medical attention.
If in eyes	If eye contact occurs hold eyes open and rinse cautiously with water for several minutes.
If on skin	If skin or hair contact occurs remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water.
If inhaled	Remove patient to fresh air.

STORAGE AND SEGREGATION

Storage: Store in original container, tightly closed, away from direct sunlight, in a cool, dry place, avoiding temperatures below 0°C and above 35°C. Store away from foodstuffs. Keep out of reach of children.

Aggregate Storage Volume Thresholds: When stored with substances of the same hazard the aggregate quantity must be considered. For full details refer to the current NZS8409 Management of Agrichemicals and the HSNO Regulations.
