Vehicle accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Call the emergency services: Dial 111
Spill or leak	In case of spillage it is important to take all steps necessary to avoid eye and skin contact and avoid environmental contamination. Keep all bystanders away. Wear full length clothing and PVC gloves. Reposition any leaking containers so as to minimise further leakage. Dam and absorb spill with an absorbent material (eg. sand or soil). Shovel the absorbed spill into drums. Disposal of the absorbed material will depend on the extent of the spill. For quantities up to 50L, bury in an approved landfill. For quantities greater than 50L seek advise from the manufacturer before attempting disposal. Contain in a secure location until disposal method is established. Decontaminate the spill area with detergent and water and rinse with the smallest volume of water practicable.
