**Safety Directions**

Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Avoid inhalation of dust. Do not eat, drink or smoke while working. **First Aid**

LARVADEX 1% PREMIX, when blended into a laying poultry ration according to the "Directions For Use" given below, will control nuisance fly species which develop in manure.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

**Restrictions**

If manure from poultry fed LARVADEX is applied to land that is used for growing food crops, particularly grain, finite crop residues may occur. To avoid illegal residues:

- **DO NOT** apply manure to soil at rates > 4 dry tonnes/ha/year
- If supplying manure to a third party, ensure that they are made aware of this restraint

**Mixing directions**

Mix 500 g of LARVADEX 1% PREMIX to each tonne of the birds' normal feed. Use a mixing process which will ensure that the product is evenly distributed through the feed. Begin using the treated feed when flies become active. Continue the treatment for 4-6 weeks or until the fly population is under control. Then revert to untreated feed until the flies build up again when use of treated feed should be resumed.

**Spillage**

Any spillage of premix or of feed mixed with the premix should be cleaned up immediately, preferably by recovery and use in or as poultry feed.

**STORAGE**

Store in original container in a cool dry place, avoiding direct sunlight and temperatures above 35°C.
