APRIL TO JUNE 2025

DURING APRIL TO JUNE 2025:

- MOST JOURNEYS EVER RECORDED ACROSS THE RIVER IN HALTON over 6.88 million journeys were made over the Mersey Gateway and Silver Jubilee Bridges in April - June 2025, up 5% on last year's figure
- SILVER JUBILEE BRIDGE BREAKS NEW QUARTERLY RECORD with over 1.09 million journeys made between April – June 2025
- OVER 84,000 VEHICLES USE THE BRIDGES EVERY WEEKDAY with over 84% of vehicles using the Mersey Gateway Bridge to cross the river
- MORE CUSTOMERS CHOOSING TO REGISTER WITH MERSEYFLOW AND USE THE AUTO TOP-UP SYSTEM THAN EVER – shown by over 93% of customers using digital or automated payment methods
- PCNs DECREASED SLIGHTLY AS A PERCENTAGE OF OVERALL JOURNEYS almost 98% of journeys were paid for on time
