OCTOBER TO DECEMBER 2023


DURING OCTOBER TO DECEMBER 2023:

- **SILVER JUBILEE BRIDGE HITS 1 MILLION JOURNEY MILESTONE** – with over 1.01 million journeys made between October-December 2023
- **2023 MARKS THE BUSIEST FOURTH QUARTER SINCE THE MERSEY GATEWAY OPENED** – over 6.39 million journeys were made over the River Mersey in Halton in this quarter
- **OCTOBER 2023 WAS THE BUSIEST MONTH EVER FOR JOURNEYS** – with over 2.2 million crossings made in this month
- **MORE PEOPLE ARE CHOOSING TO CROSS USING THE SILVER JUBILEE BRIDGE** – which accounts for over 15% of journeys made across the River Mersey in Halton
- **OVER 92% OF CUSTOMERS STILL CHOOSING DIGITAL PAYMENT METHODS** – almost 140,000 payments were made using the merseyflow Quick-Pay App in October 2023, the highest monthly figure recorded since the app launched

All revenue, either from tolls/charges or PCNs, contributes towards payment for the Mersey Gateway Bridge. It is not retained by the council or any of its contractors.



PCNs issued




Bridge usage from October – December 2023

Over 97% of customers paid their toll/charge on time


