
#### **DURING JULY TO SEPTEMBER 2025:**

- MOST JOURNEYS EVER RECORDED ACROSS THE RIVER IN HALTON over 6.95 million journeys were made over the Mersey Gateway and Silver Jubilee Bridges in July September 2025
- OVER 84,000 VEHICLES USE THE BRIDGES EVERY WEEKDAY with over 84% of vehicles using the Mersey Gateway Bridge to cross the river
- MORE CUSTOMERS CHOOSING TO REGISTER WITH MERSEYFLOW AND USE THE AUTO TOP-UP SYSTEM THAN EVER – shown by over 94% of customers using digital or automated payment methods
- PCNs REMAIN LOW AS A PERCENTAGE OF OVERALL JOURNEYS over 97% of journeys were paid for on time

All revenue, either from tolls/charges or PCNs, contributes towards payment for the Mersey Gateway Bridge.


#### Year on year traffic increases

#### Total journeys and number of PCNs issued




# PCNs remain low as a percentage of overall journeys






#### Bridge usage from July – September 2025
