

Make Your Own Paper Plate Wings!

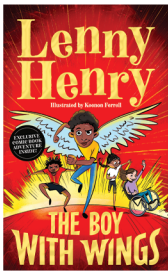
Are you ready for an extraordinary adventure this World Book Day?!
Dress up as Tunde – aka The Boy With Wings – with this easy to create costume



You will need...

- 8 Paper plates
- Scissors
- Glue or double-sided sticky tape
- String or thin elastic
- Small screwdriver to make holes
- Sticky tape
- A Yellow t-shirt
- Blue Jeans





Instructions

Take care when using glue and be especially careful when cutting with scissors!

1



Cut 5 of the paper plates in half

2



Using a new plate as the centre, turn one half plate over and firmly stick the corner to the rim.

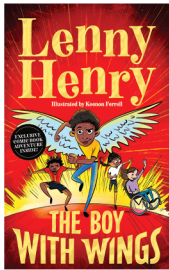


Continue attaching half plates keeping the corners close so that they fan out.

Sticking the half plates to each other will make the wings stronger



Instructions

Take care when using glue and be especially careful when cutting with scissors!

Repeat until there are five plates stuck to each side then secure with sticky tape.

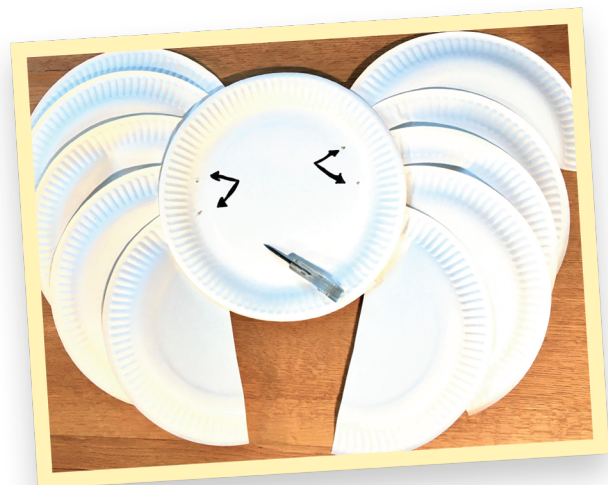
Cover the back of a new plate with glue or double-sided tape and stick firmly over the centre plate ensuring the edges are secure. This will be the front of the wings.

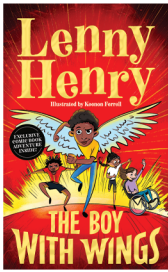


Turn the wings over and stick a new plate over the central plate. This will be the back of the wings.

Using a small screwdriver, make 4 holes at the edges of the central plate



Instructions

Take care when using glue and be especially careful when cutting with scissors!

Cut two equal lengths of string or elastic. They need to be long enough to go around the wearer's shoulders.

Turn the wings over and thread each length through both holes on one side.

Loop the string/ elastic around the wearer's shoulders and secure.

Put on the yellow t-shirt and blue jeans and you are ready to fly off on your own extraordinary adventure!
