1. Activities

How can I join in the activities?

You may enter for almost all activities through the sub-post office of the firm of Vermaat (located in the Lichtstraat on the first floor of the AZU Building, telephone 2540836). To participate in an activity you must be a member of the Personeelsvereniging and show your UMC identification card when registering. For most activities you may register a maximum of 2 persons per UMC identification card. For activities intended for children as well, you may register at most 2 adults and 3 children. You may register on 2 cards at most, meaning that you may register one colleague (upon presentation of his/her card). The number of registrations per activity is limited. An activity may be cancelled if there are not enough participants.

2. Benefits

The Personeelsvereniging has made a number or attractive arrangements with some service providers and suppliers so that members may get a discount on certain products and services. These include: Financial services / insurance:

- OHRA: discount on car insurance and extra high package discount
- Centraal Beheer: discount on loans

3. Activities for particular groups

In addition to these activities and benefits available for all members, the Ontspanningsvereniging pays specific attention to former employees.

Former employees are invited each year for a day trip somewhere in the Netherlands, followed by dinner in the UMC Utrecht.

The structure of the staff association

The Personeelsvereniging is an independent legal entity and, under its statutes, at present has a committee consisting of six members. The committee consists of UMC employees who carry out their committee tasks voluntarily in addition to their 'daily' work in the organisation, and acts on the authority of the members. The committee meets every month (sometimes more often) to ensure the activities programme is well organised.

As a member, you can join in the talk, the thinking and the decision-making behind the OV policy. Indeed, we would very much like you to do so! Every March there is a General Meeting, to which all members are welcome. We will be happy to send you (on request) the documents of the last meeting and/or the OV statutes. And if you are interested in joining the committee, please contact us! It goes without saying that you may always contact us with suggestions for the programme, etc.

Contribution, becoming a member and ending membership

The contribution amounts to no more than € 0.75 per month and will be deducted from you salary. Employees who have just started working with the UMC are automatically expected to become a member, apart from employees with a zero-hours employment (such as stand-by employees) and volunteers. If you no longer wish to be a member, you can remove your name from the membership list without giving any reason by sending a short note with your name and personnel number to the Personeelsvereniging, Or you may also inform the Salary Department (internal post C 01.314) directly. In the same way you can always become a member again.
