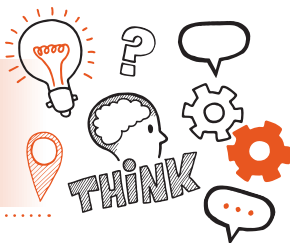

On the day of assessment, you will carry out:



A 45-minute presentation and 15-minutes Q&A



Remote or face-to-face



Under exam conditions



With an end-point assessor and your line manager (optional)



Key point

You will have already submitted your work-based project and presentation to the end-point assessor.



Do

- Review the criteria associated with the presentation - this can be found in the EPA-kit
- Use the planner to plan how you will meet the criteria that are associated with the presentation
- Ensure a quiet room is available and that there are no interruptions
- Bring any notes and work products to refer to during the presentation
- Take advantage of the full 45 minutes of the presentation
- Give clear answers to questions that reflect the level 3 standard
- Reflect on and present examples of the development of your work-based project



Don't

- Forget to plan
- Forget to check that any equipment required is available and working
- Exceed the time allocated
