On-programme duration – **Typically 30 months**



Gateway requirements – **Level 2 English and maths achieved (optional for 19+, please see funding rules), portfolio of evidence submitted and project proposal title and scope submitted**



End-point assessment method – **Multiple-choice test, project and presentation, and interview underpinned by a portfolio of evidence**

Working as a supply chain practitioner

The broad purpose of a supply chain practitioner is to move products or services from supplier to customer, ensuring customer satisfaction is achieved at all stages. Supply chain practitioners will have a broad understanding of the entire supply chain and must strive to ensure their impact on each function offers best value for their organisation and internal and external stakeholders.

This occupation is found in all organisational sectors and is a system of people, activities, information and resources involved in moving products or services from supplier to customer.

The programme's structure

Apprentices will be placed in a role, typically over 30 months, during which they will be supported while on-programme by their tutor. The tutor will review the progress of the apprentice against the standard to ensure they are prepared for the end-point assessment.

Ready for training

- Initial assessment

Set for assessment

End-point assessment methods are:

Project and presentation

- A 3,000 (+/-10%) word project report
- A 15-minute presentation followed by 30 minutes of questioning
- The assessor will ask a minimum of 6 questions

Interview underpinned by a portfolio of evidence

- A 60-minute interview, with a minimum of 6 questions asked
- Underpinned by a portfolio of evidence, which is not assessed

Multiple-choice test

- 60 minute test, consisting of 30 multiple-choice questions
