They may be responsible for business development, financial control, organisational resilience and continuity as well as for managing risk and leading on organisational change.

The programme's structure

While on programme, the apprentice will be supported by their employer and training provider to complete on and off-the-job training to acquire the knowledge, skills and behaviours required for the role. On programme, the apprentice will also undertake a regulated level 5 Diploma in Leadership and Management for Adult Care qualification. End-point assessment gateway can be commenced once the employer is satisfied that the apprentice is consistently working at or above the level set out in the standard and once all pre-requisite gateway requirements have been achieved.

- Knowledge, skills and behaviours specified in the assessment plan for this particular component
