

# Highfield **Level 3** End-Point Assessment for **Aviation Movement Specialist**



Government funding band – **£7,000**



On-programme duration – **minimum of 18 months**



Gateway requirements – **level 1 English and maths, attempted level 2 English and maths**



End-point assessment method – **on-demand test, observation with questioning, professional discussion**

## Working as a aviation movement specialist

Aviation movement specialists work in a wide range of environments that involve all kinds of landing platforms/ runways and aircraft types. This ranges from heliports and small airfields all the way through to multi-runway global airport hubs.

They provide the necessary under wing ground service support to aircraft as required. They will ensure the safe and efficient movement and recovery of fixed and rotary wing aircraft and the safety of other team members involved in aircraft arrival and departures. They also take responsibility for the safety of team members and themselves using highly specialised equipment to move aircraft within an aviation environment in accordance with standard operating procedures.

## The programme's structure

During this programme the apprentice will learn a wide range of skills and knowledge in several aviation environments, such as a commercial airport, military base/aerodrome, heliport or other airfields. They will be placed in an aviation role over a minimum of an 18-month period, during which they will be supported while on-programme by their assessor. The assessor will review the progress of the apprentice during this period against the standard to ensure they are prepared for the end-point assessment.

### Set for assessment on completion of training and functional skills

**End-point assessment methods are;**  
**On-demand test**

- 1-hour on-demand multiple-choice test

**Observation with questioning**

- 2-hour observation, 90-minute session of observation and a 30-minute question and answer session. This is to clarify knowledge and understanding of the subject matter.

**Professional discussion**

- structured discussion focusing on how the apprentice has performed during the apprenticeship and their overall achievement of the standard. The apprentice may identify supporting evidence to bring to the professional discussion to illustrate performance

### Go further
