	have that are associated with the simulated observation
\Box	Be prepared to demonstrate your practice on a 'dummy' patient
	Be prepared to answer questions that your end-point assessor
	may have
	Make sure you use the time allocated to you for reading the
	information provided prior to starting each task



	Forget to plan
\Box	Forget to tell your colleagues and other relevant people that
	you are being observed
	Forget to bring your ID
