Review relevant legislation, regulations and your organisation's policies and procedures
Use the planner to plan how you will demonstrate the skills and behaviours that are associated with the practical observation
Be prepared to reflect on your on-programme experiences and learning and identify real-life examples
Don't
Forget to bring your ID
Forget to tell your colleagues and customers you are being observed
Forget to have tasks prepared that you can complete if your
planed activity cannot go ahead or if the business is quiet
