Overview

This standard is being developed for those who wish to join the hospitality and catering sector or for those currently in the industry and are wanting to advance their career.

Production chefs work as part of a team in time-bound and often challenging kitchen environments in education, health and social care, the military and commercial/food retail.

On this apprenticeship, learners will develop knowledge, skills and behaviours in areas such as:

- kitchen operations
- nutrition
- legal and governance
- people
- business/ commercial
- personal development



Standard Structure

The end point assessment period will only commence when the employer is satisfied that the learner is working to the operational standards.

Once through the gateway, the assessment methods will be planned and booked with the Highfield Scheduling Team.

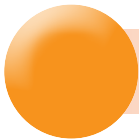
The 3 assessment methods can be conducted in any order.

Set for assessment

The end-point assessment methods are:

On-demand Test:

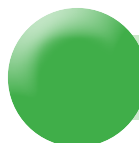
- is a 60-minute exam (including 10-minute reading time) consisting of 30 multiple choice questions.

Practical Observation:

- is a 2-hour observation of the learner followed by a question-and-answer session. The observation will cover preparation and service, with the timings split accordingly.

Professional Discussion:

- is a 40-minute structured meeting between the learner and the independent end point assessor.
