- 5 How does the book play with the idea of destiny and changing your fate?
- 6 How does Amie's role as Mariama's servant impact their relationship? What narrative techniques does Mina Fears use to develop the tension and romantic potential between the two leads?
- 7 Do themes of class and power have a large impact on characters in the book?
- In what ways does location impact the themes of the novel? How do the main settings of the palace and the desert compare?
- 9 What do you think of Amie's relationship with her sister? How does it compare to her relationship with her fellow maid servants?
- What role does magic play in the story? How does the author develop its importance using symbolism and other narrative techniques?
