





How to Draw Charlie Cook

Look at the pictures below to learn how to draw Charlie Cook. Trace the grey lines to practise as you go.







- 1 Start by drawing the nose. Then add a smiley mouth and a square chin.
- ? Add the face. Draw eyes, eyebrows and a small C-shaped ear.
- 3 Draw Charlie's hair. Use lots of little lines going in different directions.








- 4 Draw Charlie's neck, shoulder and back. Add a line for the bottom of his shirt.
- 5 Add Charlie's arm. Draw a little line up from the bottom of the shirt.
- 6 Now draw the legs. Draw them bent and at an angle to look like he's walking.

 \overline{I} Draw a rectangle at the end of each leg and two shoes. Don't forget to add the soles.




8 Draw the hands. This is tricky! Start with the thumb. Charlie will be holding books.



9 Add a stack of books balancing on the hands you drew in step 8.



10 Finally, add details. Draw shoelaces, trouser stitching and book titles.



Now draw your own picture of Charlie Cook. The nose has been drawn for you.







