We are four weeks into the season now and have several updates...

GSM Reporting

Several things are not being reported correctly on GMS:

SCORE REPORTING – this is an update to GMS not reflected in the 'Team Admin GMS Reminders' leaflets.

- BOTH sides must enter the score AND cards for BOTH teams ASAP after a match.
 - Even if '0', enter the number of all goals and cards (Green, Yellow, Red) for <u>BOTH teams</u>.
 - o For all scores, including 0-0, <u>BOTH teams</u> to report the score.
 - All elements, goals and cards, to be recorded in the Match Sheet (Timeline).
- ALL games involving Development teams should be recorded as 0-0.
 - Teams can record the goal scorers in the Match Sheet (Timeline) to keep a record if required.

Even if a team scores '0' it must be reported.

In the Score submission window, 'Scores – Create', fill in <u>all fields</u> for goals and cards for <u>both teams</u> and press the 'Save' button. Ensure <u>all 8 fields</u> are filled in, even if all are '0'.

The following Match Sheet (Timeline) window is where the goal scorers and card details (player and minutes) must be added, and 'Final Version' checkbox ticked.

UMPIRES

Two umpires must be reported for <u>all games</u>, including Development. Please **double-check before the game** to make sure <u>two umpires</u> are listed on the Team Sheet.

Officiating – Club Cluster Leads



Player Registration/Transfers

New players

Please ensure <u>all players</u> are registered before the start of the game, as **completion of Team/Match Sheets for ALL League games is <u>compulsory</u></u>. As per the Regulations, fines will be issued for non-compliance.**

Always check if a new player has previously played for another Club. If the player has previously played for another club, they <u>MUST initiate a Transfer on GMS</u> and not just create a new GMS account to register with the new club. This is relevant to all players, U18s as well as Adults.

Dual registration

Please note that dual registration for those living partially away from home (Regulation 7.4), such as university students, is <u>only permitted</u> at Grade 3 and below, and if the two Clubs play in different League Areas (i.e. the second Club is not in the Midlands League Area).

There are several outstanding transfers on the GMS, please can all Club Admins check and process ASAP.

Doubling Up Clarification

We've noticed from the first two weeks' team sheets that the doubling up element of the updated Fair Selection Regulation is not being followed as required. Please see a reminder below:

8.3.2 Conditions for Doubling Up:

- Permitted at Grades 4 and 5 only to ensure that matches take place.
- Permitted only as a last resort to cover player shortage.
- Generally allowed for lowest or second-lowest ranked teams only and no more than two teams apart in the Club's hierarchy of teams.
- Maximum of 12 players for the lower-ranked team for whom players are doubling up.
- Maximum of three players can double up, including goalkeeper.
- Excludes designated Development Teams.

We will be checking and enforcing compliance. Breaches could result in points deductions and result reversals.


Consent on GMS

Please remind all your players that for Midlands Hockey data to be meaningful all players need to update their GMS Profiles to allow 'consent' for their names to appear in the match details on the Midlands website.

Process for individuals:

Consent can be given or withdrawn via an individual's profile on the GMS.

• From the home screen, click on your name in the top left-hand corner to open your profile:



 On the next screen, select the 'Consents' tab, here you can tick the 'Opted In' or 'Opted Out' check boxes to consent or withdraw consent for your name to appear in Match Sheets on the Midlands website:



• If a player does not tick either box it will be assumed that consent is not given and therefore the name will not be shared.
