The West Adult League Committee is keen to keep Clubs engaged in the running of the League. A key part of this is the Regulations by which we govern the competition. This process is to enable Clubs to have an input to changes to Regulations that will help improve Adult hockey in the West

HOW CAN CLUBS PROPOSE LEAGUE REGULATION CHANGES?

The League Regulations are agreed ahead of each season by the ASC following input from each Area League. The aim is to have common Regulations across all 8 Areas, but some variations are required/allowed.

The West Area League encourages and welcomes input from Member Clubs in the ongoing process of rule development and improvement by means of the process below

PROCESS

Proposals to be submitted via a form at the following link

Proposals must come via a Club Administration Officer registered on GMS

Proposals can be submitted at any time of the year

All proposals will be discussed at the next appropriate Executive meeting

Feedback to be given to Clubs, either with rejection explanation, a variation suggestion or confirmation that it will be put forward to the national review.

Updates will also be discussed at all Forums and the Annual Meeting

Final submissions for a particular season of all change proposals will be finalised at the December Executive

The ASC finalise the rules in June/July for the new season and these will be circulated to clubs with changes/key points highlighted by the Area League Committee
