LATEST NEWS ABOUT THE GAME MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

We are pleased to inform clubs that player registration is now available on GMS and clubs can start to register players at all levels again. Players can register using: <https://gms.englishockey.co.uk>

Anyone that has already registered does not need to do so again. Instructions on how to register are here if required: <https://www.englishockey.co.uk/play/gms-player>

This process will be followed by leagues & competitions starting to require teamsheets & matchesheets to be completed, this is starting with the Area Adult Premier Divisions and will work through the structure progressing steadily over the coming weeks. Each Area League & Competition will communicate when they expect teamsheets & matchesheets to be used, the timing will vary from Area to Area. The teamsheet & matchesheets capture appearances, scorers and card details that will allow a player and a club to build up detailed hockey histories over time.

Improvements are continuing to be made to the GMS System, the focus has been on the performance of the system at peak times. In the last two weekends good steps forward were made on this and now the focus is back on continuing to improve system functionality.

The <https://matches.englishockey.co.uk/> site now includes junior and England Hockey Championship fixtures. Clubs can see all their results in one place by double clicking on one of their club teams results.

There are already over 4000 members of England Hockey Officiating representing so many of the club umpires that are out supporting the game every week. This club offers free and paid membership opportunities and allows officials to be part of the wide officiating community.

They typically have 5 schools playing in pools at each of the 4 venues am. 10x4 abbreviated matches.(40)

A great lunch is then put on at Kent College for teachers, coaches, and officials.

One school from each pool is eliminated after the morning with the remaining 16 competing in two parallel competitions, the Plate at Polo Farm and the Trophy at Kent College.

- Page 13 onwards takes you through the expenses claim process.
- Please be aware that currently only the league games are entered on to the system as the Finance Director needs to enter every competition on to the system manually.
- This will be done as quickly as possible.



SPITTING BY PLAYERS; A REMINDER

“Player Spitting & Nose Blowing

Spitting or nose blowing (where there is no handkerchief or tissue is used) is a practice that unfortunately occurs in our sport and must stop as it poses a significant risk to other participants.

Guidance for the 2021/22 Season

A 2-minute suspension (Green Card) to be issued to any player or participant caught spitting or nose blowing without a handkerchief or tissue. These areas should be cleaned by the offending player before play can continue.

Repeat offenders (i.e. player(s) offending more than once) subject to further personal penalties as prescribed in section 14 of the 2019 FIH Rules of Hockey.

Consistent repeat offenders will be subject to due process under the England Hockey Code of Ethics and Behaviour, Red Card, MMO and/or Disrepute policies.
