State School Update

State Secondary School Teacher Training

As part of our commitment to build hockey within State Schools, we arranged a secondary school teacher training workshop on Thursday 14 March 2024 for any school teachers who had signed up for one of the Area State School Festivals.

The workshop was aimed at introducing hockey to Secondary School teachers and covered the following:

- Benefits of delivering hockey as a sport - gender equal, leveller etc
- Overcome concerns about teaching hockey and explore solutions to common challenges e.g. facilities, equipment, safety, rules.
- Give some 'take away' fun and engaging introductory games.
- Explore next steps and where to get further resources and development.

Following this workshop, we would be happy to work with Counties to arrange a bespoke course in your locality for secondary and primary school teachers.
