Last season we had 52 teams from 34 different clubs in the men's leagues. This has now increased to 63 men's teams and 19 women's teams from 43 different clubs across London, South Central and South East.

We no longer have the Men's O40 South division as a number of these teams have moved to our MO50s and a couple have had players move back into club numbered sides. With so many new men's teams we have now been able to create a second Men's O50 and O60 division.

There's no doubt Masters hockey is still growing. There is an increasing number of summer leagues and festivals all over the Area with activity at Amersham & Chalfont, Guildford, Southgate, Basingstoke, Surbiton, Old Cranleighan to name but a few.

London Hockey has started a new mid-week social Masters initiative. It started on the 6th May 2025 and runs on Tuesdays every 2 weeks 12-2pm at Surbiton HC. These are fun, social play and pay type sessions for Men O65 (born 1960 or earlier) and Women O60 (born 1965 or earlier). £15 to include some pizza and a drink. Sessions are open to players from all Areas.

Strategy

League structures are expanding, which is great. We are still keen to attract more South East and South Central teams so we can offer Masters leagues in all age groups in all Areas in the South of England. This helps to keep travel time down for teams.

This year we also offered 'Casual Masters'. A new category for teams that are primarily maters age but want to include some youngsters U18, such as father and sons or mothers and daughters. Although we didn't get enough teams talking this up this year, we will continue to offer it as another option to competitive league hockey.

The leagues will continue to be administered by London Hockey Masters. The Area League Delivery Committee remains as Sara Walker, David Lloyd-Williams, Maureen Henderson and Paul Marks. My thanks to the group for all their help and support delivering the leagues again this year. Thanks too go to John Ingram-Marriot for all his helps and support with the Supervets Alliance merger. An invitation has been extended to John to join our ALDC.

Representative Teams

Following a search in all the clubs at Christmas time, a further 90 players came forward for consideration for our London teams this year. London Masters now has over 650 members of which approximately 275 were selected to represent the Area.

In the Area championships we entered 15 age group squad with the addition of a MO75 joint with SC and SE and our WO70 joint with SE in their friendly 7 a-side tournament.

The age group leads have all been excellent and lead their teams with enthusiasm and drive. We have had a full-on trials and training programme for all age groups. This year we have had 4 new age group leads plus several managers to support the squads.

We have also moved to formal process of paying our coaches. Coaches are now contracted to London Hockey and fees managed directly through invoicing. Thirteen squads had coaches this year.

Many thanks to all our age group leads, managers and coaches who have worked so hard this year. Players seemed to have really enjoyed the tournaments.

London Wayfarers and King's House School Sports Ground has one again been our London base and my thanks to them for their great support and hospitality.

London hosted 2 Area tournaments this summer. The MO35 was at Southgate HC and the WO35 was held at Surbiton HC. My thanks to David Lloyd Williams and Mark Bennett for being the TO and TD at Southgate and to Steve Quincey as TO and his team at Surbiton for all their great organising and delivery. Both tournaments were a great success.

Huge thanks too, to Peter Mackintosh and Graeme Hope from London Officiating who have appointed all the umpires to our tournaments. They have used them as development opportunities and put great teams in place with umpire managers to support all umpires.
