CLOSED – do not discuss.

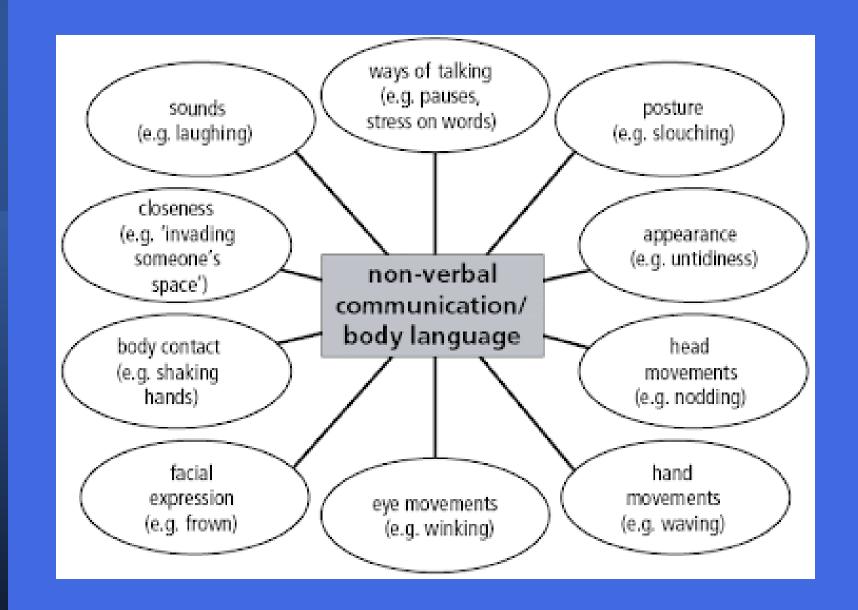
CLEAR – keep to the point.

- Shoulders back.
