Thanks also to the teams for looking after the officials and making them generally feel welcome and a part of the process.

Several people doubled up to cover two matches, or even more when adding in club games too. A fantastic effort all round.

Our apologies if you were expecting umpires but they weren't available. The enrolment into EHO has also caused some problems, meaning that some umpires weren't able to enter their availability and, hence, get appointments.


Many of you will have umpired for your clubs, often doing multiple matches. Many thanks to you too, for keeping the league matches happening right across the Area.

To anyone who has registered as a Silver member – please be aware that this is for people who are only planning to undertake up to 5 or 6 appointments in a season. IF you want to do more then you should be looking for Gold membership. If you need to change your membership grade then please get in touch.

We currently have around 150 Bronze members, which seems very low for the number of clubs and teams that we have in the Area. A reminder that anyone who umpires, or will umpire, any game of hockey needs to register to be a member of EHO, at the Bronze (free) level if you don't wish to undertake appointments. If you are umpiring club games you do need to be a registered member of EHO.

### **Expenses**

As we speak the officiating expenses policy is being reviewed by the Area Board and we hope to publish shortly.

Once you have officiated at a game you can enter the mileage in the fixture report on GMS. No final total will be shown until the expenses policy has been agreed and added to GMS. Once it has been then the system should automatically update the claims with the relevant amount.



### **Non-League Matches**

The appointing team are also beginning to appoint to other matches – schools games, tournaments and some BUCS games are coming up. We are hoping to get those into GMS soon but, in the meantime, the appointers are having to appoint via e-mail, so please bear with us.

# Given a Red Card or MMO – What to do next?

So, you've given a Red Card (RC) or issued a Matchday Misconduct Offence (MMO) and you don't know what to do. Don't worry read this.

(A MMO is an offence committed by a player either before or after a match that would have resulted in a Red Card being given on the match. Sadly, it is normally given for umpire abuse. The same form is used to report a MMO so any references on what to do about Red Cards is the same for MMOs)

A Red Card is a rare event in hockey, most umpires will only give a couple in their entire umpiring careers, so



most umpires don't know what happens next.

Firstly, when you give a Red Card make sure that you document what happened, especially the players name and shirt number. Equally important to note down if the person is U18. If abuse has been given, then write down what was said. Don't worry if this delays the game, the person who has got the Red Card needs time to leave the pitch before you restart the game. Remember that the captain has a responsibility to provide you with this information if the player won't or talking to the player is not a good idea!

After the match, take a few minutes to gather your thoughts and complete any notes. At this point it is a good idea to contact the Discipline Team to let you know that a Red Card has been given. Your contacts are

Next you need to complete the paperwork. Don't worry, there is not a lot of it and it is easy to fill in. The latest version of the form can be found at <u>https://www.englandhockey.co.uk/governance/rules-and-regulations/discipline-and-disrepute/red-cards-and-mmos</u> download a copy - you could always keep a copy of it in your kit bag, just in case.

Filling in the form is straight forward, in fact England Hockey provide instructions on the same web page. But most of the boxes are easy to fill in. Please give as much information as you can, details about the state of the match are useful to the discipline team.

Having completed it, sign it (if doing it on a computer – just type your name in the relevant box) and send it the ADA and Deputy using the email addresses above. Send a copy to your umpiring colleague for them to add their thoughts – and that is all you have to do.




