



Midlands Hockey Ltd. Youth Support Grant

Regulations required for an application by a Midlands Club to the Company for a Grant

- The Board will request Midlands Hockey Ltd. to publicise the availability of the Grant and place the Grant application form on the Midlands Hockey Ltd. Website.
- The Grant will be between £300 to £1000 for each individual Midland Club applying for a Grant. A Midland Club can only receive one Grant in any 12-month period.
- The grant application form will include the following:
 - Midland Club provides a copy of the England Hockey ClubMark accreditation with the grant application form. (The England Hockey ClubMark accreditation ensures that the Midland Club has recognised standards in respect of youth hockey development);
 - A brief description of the youth development which the Grant is being applied to fund;
 - An analysis of the proposed expenditure to be incurred on youth hockey development and an analysis how it is proposed to be funded;
 - Midland Club confirms that the proposed expenditure has not already been contracted for;
 - Copy of the latest financial statements;
 - The grant application form will provide a link to the Company's Data Privacy Notice
- Midland Clubs will submit the Grant application form by email.
- The Board can impose additional conditions on the Midland Club when agreeing to make a Grant to the Midland Club.
- If the Board agrees to make a Grant to a Midland Club, then the Midland Club will enter into a non-negotiable grant agreement with the Company.
- The grant agreement will include the following terms:
 - Midland Club represents that the Grant will be spent on youth hockey development. Any part of the Grant not spent on youth hockey development will be repaid by the Midland Club to the Company;
 - The Midland Club will provide documentary evidence of its bank details, such as a bank statement, to the Company;
 - The Midland Club represents that it will spend the Grant within 12 months of receipt from the Company and the Grant will be repaid to the Company if not spent after 12 months;
 - The Midland Club will provide documentary evidence of the expenditure on youth hockey development including invoices and bank statements to the Board 12 months after the Grant was made. If the Midland Club does not provide the documentary evidence to the Board within 14 months after the Grant was made, then the Grant will be repaid;
 - Any additional conditions imposed by the Company for making the Grant;



- The Member Club will accept the grant agreement by email.
- The Board will request MH to put the amounts of Grants and the Midland Clubs receiving the Grants on the MH website.
- The decision of the Board on whether to make a Grant to a Midland Club is final and not subject to appeal by a Midland Club in respect of an unsuccessful Grant application.
