

Captain's Quick Reference | 2025-26

- This guide provides a summary of key points to help teams comply with Area League Regulations

- If you are uncertain about the application of any Regulation please contact your Divisional Secretary.

CRITICAL CHANGES

- Fixture Confirmation: Home teams MUST contact opposition to confirm fixture details (5.2)
- Match Sheet Deadline: ALL GRADES must complete match sheets by 2000 hrs on match day
- Umpiring: Grade 3 minimum requirement is Level 1 Assessed (11.0)
- Conduct Responsibility: You are responsible for conduct of club officials not in spectator area (12.1)
- Player Registration Deadlines All players must be registered in GMS by the weekly cut-off (7.6.1);
 final registration date 1 Feb (7.6.2).

ESSENTIAL CAPTAINS DUTIES

Before the Match

- **HOME captains**: Confirm fixture details (time, venue, kit, floodlights, weather plan) with opposition before fixture, in particular when details have changed from those originally in GMS (5.2)
- AWAY captains: Respond confirming no kit clash & hospitality participation (6.6)
- Verify all players are registered and eligible; register new players before match day (7.6.1)
- Confirm umpiring arrangements if not Area appointed. Grade 3 requires Level 1 Assessed (11.0)
- Club umpires to be registered in GMS as umpires and with EHO (11.4)
- GRADE 2: Confirm match details to Area appointed umpires no later than 3 days prior to the fixture

Match Day

- Complete team selection in accordance with Team Selection Regulations
- Include all players, substitutes, officials and umpires on team sheet (9.1)
- **GRADES 4 & 5 ONLY,** where applicable comply with **doubling-up restrictions**: Maximum of **13 players** when doubling-up (increased from 12) and **maximum of two games** per player per match day (8.4.2)
- Playing kit must meet the requirements, including shirt numbers (10.5)
- Ensure bench area compliance: only players & officials allowed (6.1.5), no spectators within 5m
- Complete match sheet and result in GMS by 20:00 hrs (or ASAP if a late pushback)

Post-Match

- Report any regulation breaches to ALMC within 7 days (15.4)
- Complete umpire feedback for Area appointed umpires by Wednesday 20:00 hrs (11.4)
- Manage player suspensions suspended players cannot be selected (12.2)
- Ensure compliance with England Hockey's Code of Ethics and Behaviour in all social media posts

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

☐ All players registered in GMS before match; ensure squad complies with Team Selection rules☐ Confirm Selection Exemption Pass (SXP) if required for unusual selections
☐ Verify no current suspensions via disciplinary records
REQUIRED COMMUNICATIONS & DEADLINES
☐ Match day 2000 hrs : Match sheet and results submission
☐ Wednesday 2000 hrs : Umpire reports (Grade 2 only, for Area appointed officials)
