We are looking for an individual aged 16 or over with a passion for inspiring people from diverse backgrounds to get active through the power of hockey. This role blends coaching with community development and is focused on engaging underrepresented groups of all ages in Birmingham.

As part of your apprenticeship, you will take part in structured learning and on-the-job training while helping build a more inclusive hockey community.

Roles & Responsibilities

- Be a positive role model, particularly for communities that are currently underrepresented in hockey.
- Support the delivery of fun and engaging hockey sessions and activities in the community.
- Develop relationships with local people, schools, and partner organisations.
- Assist with planning and delivering school and community outreach sessions.
- Support the Head Coach to deliver hockey programmes across the region.

Skills & Experience – Desirable but not essential

This is an apprenticeship programme, designed to help you gain skills and experience on the job.

Any prior experience in sports coaching or community engagement is a bonus; however, certain personal qualities and characteristics are a must (see below).
