## **League Structures**

Please find the Men's and Women's League Structures for 2024-25 on the Midlands website.

The Women's League has been restructured as per the consultation at the end of last year, i.e.:

- Division 2s split East/West to assist travelling.
- Division 4s renamed and some movement for a geographic alignment.
- Divisions 5 & 6 merged and aligned within following guidelines. There were a number of iterations before we arrived at the final assignments.
- Maximise teams in Divisions (impacted by total number of teams available so not all Divisions an optimal 12).
- Balance teams geographically to try and minimise travel (using astro post codes provided). To assist we have removed the Development-only Divisions.

Due to the teams at the peripheries of the Midlands this has not been possible for all Divisions.

NB. Next season there will be two promotions from every Division with matching relegations.

### **League Fixtures**

Now that Divisions are finalised we have started working on Fixture generation. Our target is to publish early in July.

### **League Dates**

- All Adult League Divisions will start on Saturday 28th September
- EH Championships Saturday 26th October
- Last games before winter break Saturday 7th December
- Indoor Saturday 14th & Sunday 15th December
- Restart Saturday 11th January
- EH Championships Wednesday 15th February
- Last League games Saturday 5th April.

### **Fines**

Those teams with outstanding fines should be aware that if they are not paid by the beginning of the season **ALL of their teams are liable not to keep any match points they receive until paid**. I will contact those Clubs individually.

We are very conscious that we have had to issue lots of fines last season due to GMS not being completed properly, see details below. To try and reduce the number of fines next season we are producing a leaflet of points and reminders that will contain both details of what needs to be completed and also guidance on how to complete. We plan to send copies of the leaflets to all Clubs before the start of next season. Two for each team and two extra for each Club. Their creation has been funded from fines issued last season.

### **All Clubs Meeting**

For the first time we plan to hold an **ALL Clubs Meeting** at the beginning of September. At this meeting we will discuss changes and focusses for the coming season and answer any queries you may have to make sure we have a problem free season. As per Regulation 3.1.7 **every Club MUST send a representative.** No attendance is finable.

### **Regulations**

The Areas, with England Hockey, are in the process of finalising updates to the Regulations, and this includes a major re-write and simplification of Regulation 8 PLAYER ELIGIBILITY - FAIR SELECTION. Also updated is Appendix 5 - STANDARD PENALTIES & TARIFFS OF FINES.

It also points to three new EH Regulations:

- EH Code of Conduct
- EH Disciplinary Regulations
- EH Guidance on Faith and Fixtures
- EH Transgender Participation Policy

All of which should be published before the start of the season.
