## The Role:

- · Report to the Men's Club Captain, collaborating on agreed objectives, team selection policies (working alongside Captains and the Selection Panel), and junior integration.
- $\cdot$  Deliver one training session per week (Wednesday evenings) and manage matchday coaching for the Men's 1st Team on Saturdays.
- · Plan and deliver pre-season, including player recruitment, fitness preparation, and training sessions.
- · Support wider club initiatives, such as our junior development programme.
- · (Optional) Early involvement in pre-season friendly fixtures to build squad cohesion and nurture new talent.
- $\cdot$  (Optional) Opportunity to expand the role to include additional coaching across the Men's 3rd and 4th XI squads (Thursday evenings).
