### CUTE PROGRAMME

#### Rationale:

Midlands Area Officiating Committee (MAOC) has recognised the need for improved engagement with member clubs, their umpires and Club Umpire developers.

## Club Umpire Training Events (CUTE) are designed to

- 1. Offer opportunities for the delivery of development by experienced Umpire developers to individual clubs and the emerging club clusters.
- 2. Arrange and Deliver a theory and practical training package for Umpires preparing for Level 1 assessment or Level 1 umpires requiring updates.
- **3.** Offer opportunities to network with Club Umpires considering progression to level 2 and beyond.
- **4.** Provide experienced developers to deliver practical-based sessions arranged by clubs.
- **5.** Provide experienced developers to deliver meeting-based presentations arranged by clubs.
