


Summer at The Church

Immediately upon stepping inside the Church you are immersed in over 300 years of Dublin History, your eyes are immediately drawn to the imposing Renataus Harris organ that dominates the main bar. The Church, a grade A listed building has been methodically restored and converted to respect & showcase the extensive history, culture and architecture which makes this one of the most unique hospitality buildings in the world.


First stone laid in April 1697 and St Mary's Church opened to the public in 1701

- Arthur Guinness Married here in June 1761.
- Famous Baptisms include James. Caulfield, Theobold Wolfe Tone and Sean O'Casey.
- Lord Norbury, the infamous Hanging Judge was buried in the St. Mary's graveyard.
- Among the many ceremonies celebfrated here have been 25,000 baptisms, 5,500 Marriages and 18,000 burials.
- George Frideric Handel practiced his famous Messiah on the Renatus Harris Organ.

The doors to St Mary's closed in 1964. In 1997 the building was sold and after an 8 year refurbishment project it opened in 2005 as John M Keating's Bar and Restaurant.

 The present owners, the Flynn Family, acquired the business in 2007 and rebranded the business as The Church Café Bar.
